1. Volunteer male coaches - Tuesday night basketball at the Homewood Y.M.C.A. (7140 Bennett Street, Pittsburgh, PA, 15208). Starting October 25<sup>th</sup> 2011 and running weekly through February 7<sup>th</sup> 2012.

Coaches are expected to assist us each week with basketball instruction, serving food to the kids, and leading small group discussions. Orientation and training will be provided for new volunteers. An 80 percent or more attendance record is expected to maintain and build relationships with the boys, grades 5 – 8. Some basketball knowledge is preferred.

2. Churches and/or individuals to prepare and serve dinners to the boys in our basketball program - every Tuesday evening from October 25<sup>th</sup> to February 7<sup>th</sup>. Dinners can be hot or cold and must be delivered to the Homewood Y.M.C.A. (7140 Bennett Street, Pittsburgh, PA, 15208). The group ranges from 25 to 40, but can be confirmed the day prior to each event.
3. Prayer supporters – we are wanting to build both a prayer chain for urgent prayer requests, and we also would like to establish a group of prayer partners that are willing to receive regular prayer needs and updates.
